



Take 2 Back Poker is an exciting stud poker game played against a pay table. Players are dealt three cards to combine with two community cards to make a five-card poker hand. Winning hands are based on a pay table. The skill is determining whether to 'Take Back' one of three equal bets after receiving the initial three cards, and then again after the first community card is revealed.

HOW TO PLAY



The player must make three bets of equal size.



After the player receives their initial three cards, they may 'Take Back' the first bet or keep it up.



After the first community card is revealed, the player may 'Take Back' the second bet or keep it up.

After the second community card is revealed, the value of the Player's 5-card poker hand is compared to the posted pay table, and winning hands are paid on all remaining wagers (except the optional 3 Card side bet).



The optional 3 Card side bet pays according to the pay table if the Player's first three cards contain a Pair or better.
